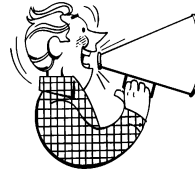

BUILT OF LIVING STONES

As a Faith Community we have begun a journey to design and build a new church building for our parish and for the greater honor and glory of God. This is the eighth article in a series that we started eight weeks ago. These articles are taken from the book "Built of Living Stones, Art Architecture and Worship," published by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

*Liturgical Principles for Building
or Renovating Churches*

The basic liturgical principles for designing and renovating churches today are drawn from the second Vatican Council and the documents that implemented its decrees. Even though the church offers no universal blueprint or style for the design of a church, attention to the following principles will insure that from the beginning, the ritual requirements will receive the priority they deserve in the design process.

The Church building is designed in harmony with church laws and serves the needs of the liturgy. The liturgical books are the foundational source for those who wish to plan a building well suited for the liturgy. First among these are the prescriptions contained in the fifth chapter of the General Instruction of the Roman Missal and the norms in the introduction to the Rite of Dedication of a Church and an Altar. Other directives can be found in the various liturgical books and the Code of Canon Law.

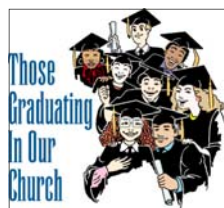
